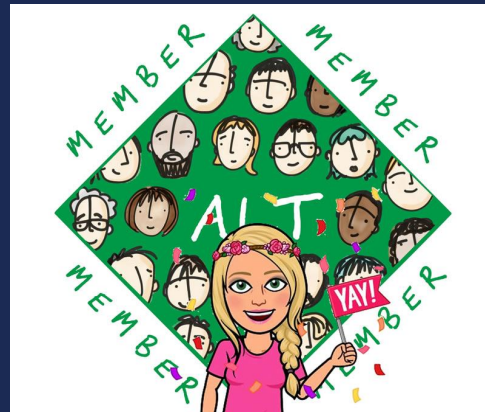

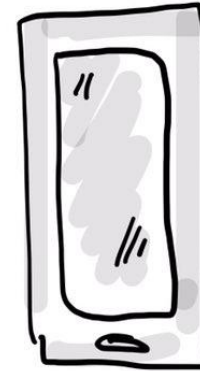

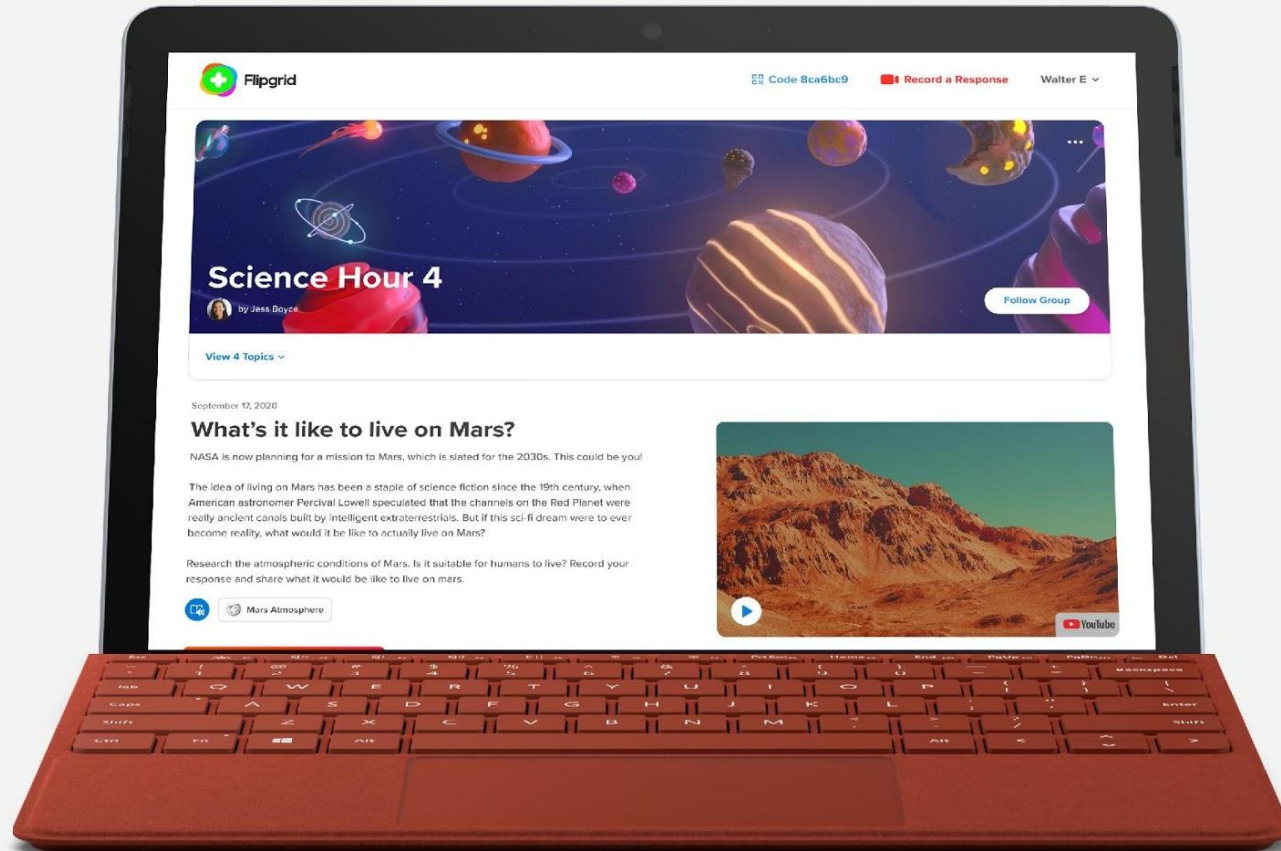

Share to start a conversation!

1) Create a Topic




A Flipgrid **Topic** is a discussion prompt... a question, idea, experiment, debate, exploration, or anything you want to ignite conversation among your community.



2) Set Access and Share






You decide who will get access to your Flipgrid Topic! You can enter your school's email domain, set up unique identifiers for each learner, invite specific email addresses, or a combination of the above!




Share your learning...

Students join using their School Email.

Students join using their Microsoft or Google email.

Create a list of students to join.

Allowed Emails

Add the email domains or individual emails your participants will use to join the Group.

Guest Password (Optional)

After securing your Topic, all you need to do is **share the unique code** by copying and pasting the link wherever your community connects or via one of the share buttons.

Your community will then use this code to join the discussion.

3) Foster Social Learning

Your community can access Flipgrid on any computer via flipgrid.com on the Microsoft Edge or Google Chrome browser or on the free Flipgrid iOS or Android app.

Here students can add a video and watch videos from peers!

The findings suggest that the levels of reflective thinking evidenced by the majority of participants were, on average, more critical and less descriptive than those in Stoszowski and Collins' (2017) study, which employed text-based (i.e. written)
