





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- 13. Over 1,500 prescriptions were identified as part of the fraud, to the value of £76,475. It was confirmed, as part of the investigation, that the actual cost of the medicines was £4,178 and the total claimed by the Registrant was £80,653. The Registrant had carried out the fraud by amending the handwritten prescriptions, to show that the more expensive form of medication had been dispensed when this was not the case.
- 14. The Registrant was interviewed under caution when he answered "no comment" to all guestions. Following a lengthy investigation he was reinterviewed 15 months later, when he supplied a prepared statement admitting to the fraud in full, expressed his remorse and indicated that he intended to repay the amount in full. Within a month he had repaid the total amount, using money from his company (which he will need to repay to his brothers, who were not implicated in this fraud).
