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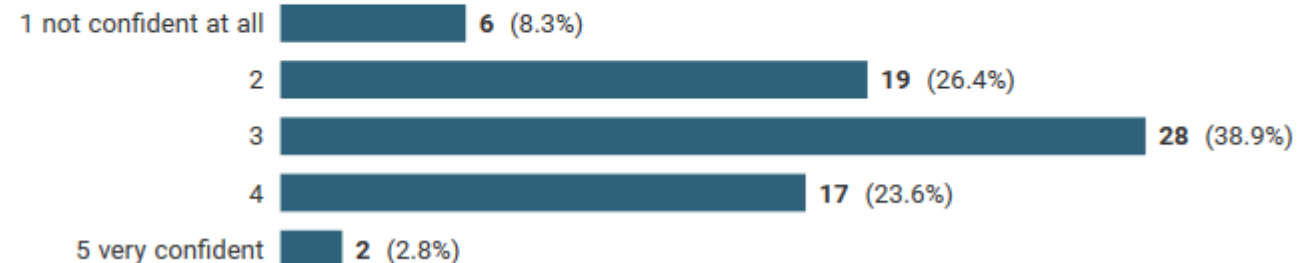

- A fact he actually dispensed a cheaper alternative such as tablets or capsules. The local investigation covered the period between April 2014 and January 2018. It was stated in Court that concerns were raised relating to the pharmacy's prescriptions for medication used, amongst others, for the treatment of dementia.

- C 13. Over 1,500 prescriptions were identified as part of the fraud, to the value of £76,475. It was confirmed, as part of the investigation, that the actual cost of the medicines was £4,178 and the total claimed by the Registrant was £80,653. The Registrant had carried out the fraud by amending the handwritten prescriptions, to show that the more expensive form of medication had been dispensed when this was not the case.
- D 14. The Registrant was interviewed under caution when he answered "no comment" to all questions. Following a lengthy investigation he was re-interviewed 15 months later, when he supplied a prepared statement admitting to the fraud in full, expressed his remorse and indicated that he intended to repay the amount in full. Within a month he had repaid the total amount, using money from his company (which he will need to repay to his brothers, who were not implicated in this fraud).
