Bring experiences and evidence together as a response to UKPSF

Owning

Building confidence in your fellowship voice

Evidencing

Clarifying the value, impact and reach of your work. Relating directly back to HE learning and teaching

Editing

Stepping out of the writer shoes to refine your case studies (Check out our Editorial Checklist

Crafting

You have license to craft your fellowship case studies in a way that best represents your practice

Sharing

Fellowship doesn't have to be lonely. Share your progress, ask colleagues to act as critical friend, join the community

Reflecting

Providing a sense of personal learning and critical analysis to your practice. You can use a model such as CARR

Refining

Tweaks to language and structure that makes sure you are making the most of your word count

Organising

Bringing logical and meaningful order to your academic narrative (not necessarily everything!)

Translating

The UKPSF might seem a little alien and so taking time to translate this and apply to your practice is a valuable step
