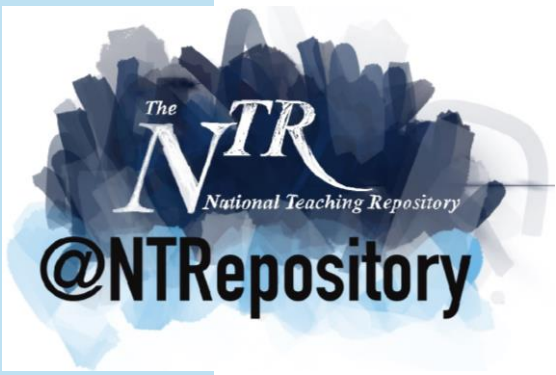

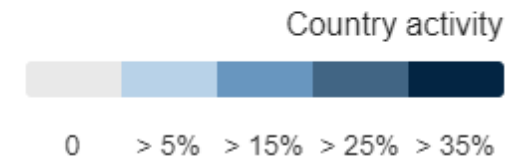
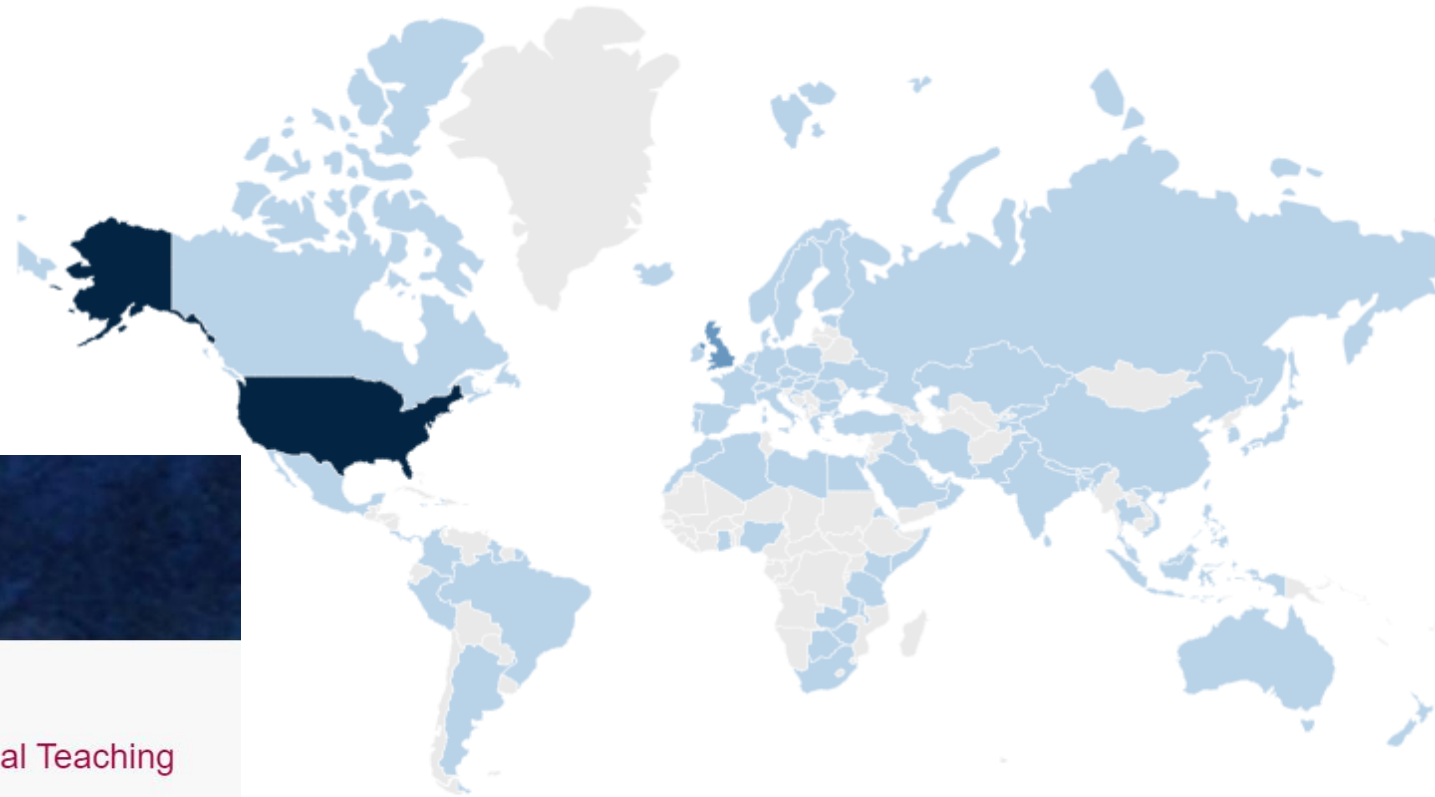
1. It is free, secure and there is no need to register in order to share
