



Rights based standards for children undergoing clinical procedures

Information Sheet for Children and Young People

We are asking if you would like to take part in a project. This sheet will tell you all about it.

What is this project doing?

• This project is asking you to share your views of using the 'Rights based standards for children undergoing clinical procedures' when you have had a test, treatment, investigation or procedure

Who is doing the project?

• The people doing the project are an international team of doctors, nurses youth workers, children and parents.

Why have I been asked to take part?

- We are asking you to take part as you are aged 7 to 16 years and we think that you can tell us your views of using the rights based standards.
- Your mum/dad/carer have said it is okay for you to take part.

What will happen to me if I say yes I want to take part?

- You will be asked to answer a few questions in this online survey about using the standards, what parts you used, what you thought about using them, what was good about the standards and what could be better.
- We want to hear your honest opinions about using the standards. There are no right or wrong answers.
- You can answer this survey on a computer, phone or laptop. The survey will take about 10 minutes to fill out, depending on how much you want to tell us.
- You will not have to answer any questions you do not want to, and you can end the survey at any time.
- We will not be asking for any information which will identify who you are. Please do not add any identifiable information to the survey.

• If you click 'done' at the end of the survey then this means you are happy for us to use your answers as part of the project. As we cannot tell who has written what, once you have clicked done then you cannot take your answers back.

Do I have to take part?

No, you do not have to take part! It is up to you whether or not to take part.
No-one will mind if you do not want to take part.

Will anyone else know I am taking part?

• Your mum/dad/carer will know that you are taking part. We will be able to see your answers, but we won't know that they belong to you.

What are the good and bad things about taking part?

• A good thing we think is that you will enjoy taking part. We do not think there are bad things, it will take you some time to fill in the survey. If you want to stop taking part then just stop, no-one will mind.

What if I have some questions?
